



2019 Scholarship Application

PenTex Energy is once again pleased to announce that it will award twenty (20) scholarships of \$1,000 each to area high school seniors or students already attending college full time (12 semester hours). These scholarships will only be available to students who reside in a residence receiving service from PenTex Energy and will be subject to confirmation that the requirements of enrollment have been met. Members of the Board of Directors, General Manager, scholarship administrator, and employees' children or grand-children are eligible for three (3) scholarships to be randomly drawn by the scholarship selection committee.

Eligibility:

1. Scholarships will be made available to active member's graduating seniors who are living full time in residences (residential metering) receiving service from PenTex Energy or for full-time college students living outside the PenTex Energy service area whose parents are members of PenTex Energy.
2. Applicant must have maintained a 2.0 GPA and demonstrate acceptable standards of citizenship and good character as evidenced by two letters of recommendation from teachers, principals, deans, counselors, etc., from the school they are attending.
3. Applicant must have been accepted in a post-secondary program at an accredited institution (two year, four year or technical) as a full-time student (at least 12 credit hours).

5. **Application must be received no later than February 15, 2019.**
6. PenTex Energy will award a scholarship to an individual only once. **In order for the scholarship payment to be issued, the student must submit to PenTex Energy proof of enrollment and proof of full-time student status from the registrar's office for the current semester. Prior to July 1, 2019 you must also supply PenTex Energy with the name of the school you will be attending, your student ID number and the name and address of the department the scholarship money shall be sent.**
7. An **"ORIGINAL"** head shot photo of the scholarship applicant must be submitted with this application to be used in future PenTex Energy publications.
